

- 5. Participants must keep up with the parade and not cause gaps to occur in the parade.
- 6. Participants must be at the staging area by the prescribed time or they will be placed at the end of the parade at the discretion of the parade staff.
- 7. Parade will begin promptly at 10:00 am, rain or shine.
- 8. You must sign up by the required date or risk being placed at the end of the parade.
- Please let us know if you have a group of small children that must start at Banneker Middle School instead of Paint Branch High School.
